

3. Correct. The answer is false. Other pollutants released in the combustion of hydrocarbon fuels can be: 1) carbon monoxide (CO) which is toxic, 2) nitric oxides (NO_x) which, in combination with water, form nitrous and nitric acid, 3) sulfur dioxide (SO₂) which reacts with water and oxygen producing sulfurous and sulfuric acid (better known for their contribution to acid rain), and 4) particulate matter.
