

**3. Correct. The answer is true.** As we can see from the table 21.8 and excel ch21, Norway is the best among the RR countries. The GNI index is 6.0, which means 6% of gross national income is spent on education. However, GNI in other countries is much lower, for example, in Eq. Guinea it is only 1.2. Norway's HDI is also relatively higher than other RR countries, indicating that the Norwegian are well educated. The higher proportion of urban population and access to electricity suggest that Norway's economy is well developed. Moreover, the lower peace index and proportion of poverty and the higher proportion of improved H<sub>2</sub>O, life expenditure and TIC means that it is comfortable for living in Norway
