

**19. Incorrect. The answer is true not false.** The worldwide median value for health expenditures as % of GDP for high income is non-RR countries is 8%. All other high income RR countries are below 6%. For the middle income non-RR countries the median is 5.5% with the majority of the RR countries below this level. Although we can't infer causality, there does seem to be a tendency.
